RE: Price increases Resulting from Tariffs

Dear Valued Supplier

We are reaching out to address the recent tariff changes enacted by the U.S. Administration, which may have implications for our business operations and supply chain partners.

As a valued supplier, we appreciate your partnership and the critical role you play in supporting our operations. However, per Senior Metal Bellow's Terms & Conditions, we do not accept unilateral price increases due to changes in tariffs. Our expectation is for our suppliers to manage their sourcing strategies to eliminate any potential adverse impacts of tariffs. Current orders will remain at the contractually agreed-to prices on the Purchase Orders. Cost increases due to tariffs on future orders will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis and must be supported with sufficient documentation.


Tariff charges invoiced without prior communication and documentation will not be paid.

Also note that purchases made under U.S. government contracts are exempt from tariffs. As such, any attempt to pass through tariff-related costs on government-funded orders is strictly prohibited and may result in non-payment and/or reevaluation of our supplier relationship.

We ask that you review your current pricing and ensure full compliance with these guidelines. If you have any questions or believe a situation warrants further discussion, please reach out to your respective buyer.
